Key Points to Note

- Asnad Bowled a fabulous spell and was the pick of the bowlers. He produced some unplayable deliveries and kept Sunny busy behind the stumps.
- New boy Akhtar bowled a great spell, particularly given he has not played for several years.
- Sarjul started with a good first over, however it was the usual leg side deliveries from second over onwards, the majority of which were dispatched to the boundary and keeping Asnad busy with ball collection.
- Fielding was on point with a great catches from Nick and Asnad (who took out SL's top hitter on 91). Also a good run out from the new boy Awais.
- SL batting just too strong although some good damage limitation bowling from Nick, K-man and Dave (the figures do not do him any justice), restricted the score to an achievable 257 from 40 Overs.

- Ren was bowled out playing onto his stumps, and continues his bad patch.
- Sarjul was promoted to opening the batting with Ren and showed some promise before playing a half-hearted shot, which sounded amazing off the bat, but was caught at mid-off.
- New boy Awais played an absolute blinder of an innings and certainly rattled SL a little.
- Mayfield mid order collapsed as per usual with 4-7 not being able to get into double figures.
- Arch nemesis Andy Battle was not able to get another five wicket haul this time, but still managed to bag two wickets with his grenades.
- Nick Starck continued his good form this season, getting a 50 but doing so with proper cricket shots and technique, unfortunately lack of support from other batsmen let him down on potentially getting a much higher score as Mayfield yet again found themselves 10 wickets down.
- M Akhtar, who was apparently could not bat at all, played a fabulous cameo scoring 23, but not remembering to ground his bat!!

All in all a good day's cricket although the batting let us down, yet again.
