### **Subscriptions and Match Fees**

Our annual subscription for 2016 is £65.00 and is due in April and if not paid by 1<sup>st</sup> June is increased to £75.00.

Match fees are £8.00 per game for members (non-members pay £10.00, but are expected to fully join after a couple of games). This includes teas.

Other benefits of membership include:

- Mayfield cricket clothing available for purchase
- Reduced ticket prices for all Mayfield CC events
- Regular club magazine, Mayfield Matters
- Use of the clubhouse facilities all year round

### **Selection and Match Day**

Members are given priority for selection for games and will be contacted by the Team Secretary (currently Dave Starck) early in the week preceding the game. The Saturday and Sunday teams are then picked and players notified.

In the event of bad weather players will be contacted if the game has to be called off – DO NOT assume a game is cancelled unless you hear from the club officials.

Home matches start at 2.00 PM and all players are expected to be at the ground to help set up the equipment by at least 1.30PM. Sunday League matches start at 1.00PM so players are to be at the ground at least an hour before hand. *(All start times are found in the fixtures pages on the website.)*

For away games the players will be informed of the time to meet to travel to the game.

After the game all players are expected to return to the clubhouse where the Captain will award the Man of the Match and the award for the Golden Moment of the game. This also gives players the opportunity to socialise and build team spirit.

All members will be asked to do teas once per season and will be reimbursed a maximum of £30.00 towards this. The captain will inform you when it is your
